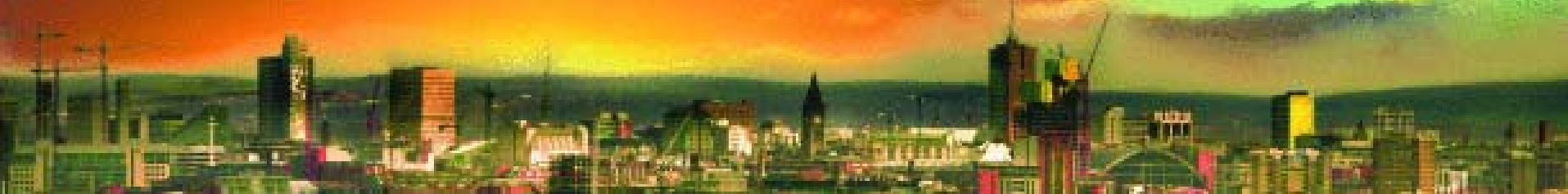

Manchester's Core Strategy

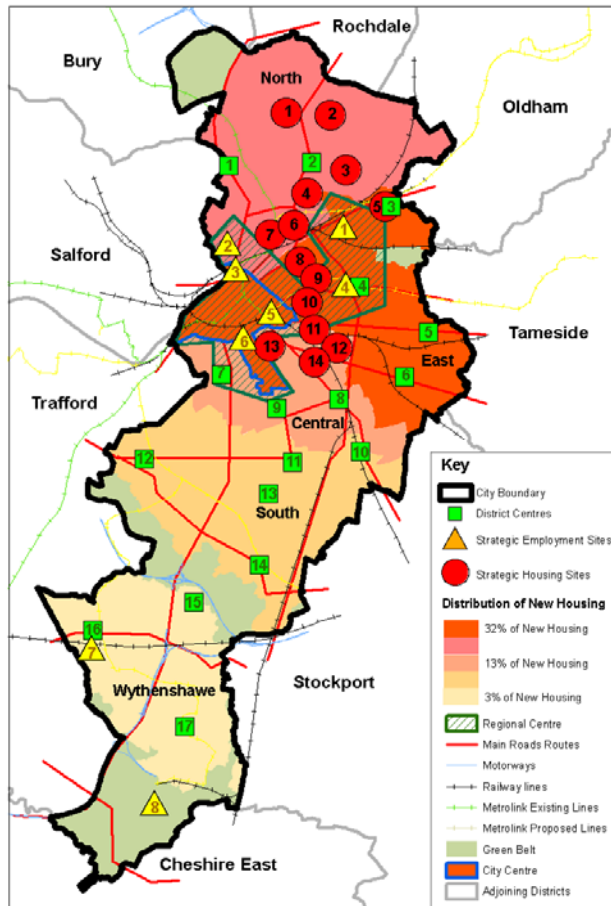
Distribution of development
